

### **Eligibility Criteria for Admission:**

Applications are invited from candidates, both male and female who have passed/appeared this year in the Higher Secondary(10+2) or its equivalent examination with English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and vernacular or any other fifth subject. The general candidates must have to secure at least 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together (40% for SC/ST candidates) and at least 30% marks in English under West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or equivalent examination of a University/ Recognized Board/Council. The selection of the candidates who have appeared will, however, be subject to their passing of the said examination before admission.

Candidates are required to appear at a written test conducted by the "West Bengal Board of Examination for Admission to Engineering, Medical & Technology Degree Colleges". The final selection of the candidates for admission is made through counseling conducted by the "Central Selection Committee". Candidates finally selected for admission, will be required to produce certificates of fitness from a Medical Officer in the prescribed form. Enrolment Form is attached with this Brochure.

### **Age Restriction:**

Candidates must be 17 (seventeen) years of age or above as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2013.

### **Duration of the Course:**

(i) The 4-year Course shall be divided into 8 independent semesters with two semesters (Odd Semester - July to December and Even Semester - January to June) in one academic year.

(ii) The number of teaching weeks in each semester shall be 16 to 18 with a minimum of 90 teaching days excluding the period of final examinations.

### **Examinations for the Degree of Bachelor of Engineering:**

There shall be eight separate regular examinations for the Degree of Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.), Viz.,

Examinations. Each such regular examination will be held at the end of each semester. The date and venue shall be notified by the Controller of Examinations of the University of Burdwan.

### **Eligibility Criteria to appear at a Semester Examination:**

A candidate may be allowed to appear at a semester examination provided he / she has been certified by the Principal of the college/institute to have prosecuted a regular course of study prescribed for the purpose for one academic semester and found eligible to appear at the examination.

A candidate must attain a minimum of 75% average attendance of all the theory and practical classes held during the session. A candidate may be allowed to appear in the semester examinations with a minimum of 60% average attendance under sufficient medical ground or grounds like participation in cultural, sports, other academic (like attending vocational training, etc) or official assignments in the interest of the Institution / University / Government with the satisfaction of the authority against payment of the condonation fee amounting to Rs 600.00 (Rupees Six Hundred only).

Attendance in individual subjects must not fall below 50% even when the average attendance reaches minimum 60% or above. If any candidate fails to attain the minimum attendance in any one individual subject, he/she will not be allowed to appear in the whole semester examination.
